



RETREAT HOUSE



The Little Lights Retreat House, located in the Anacostia neighborhood in Washington, DC, is a beautiful and modern detached house with over 2,600 square feet of space.

The house is available to groups for small group retreats, service/missions group lodging, and leadership gatherings.



The home sleeps up to 20 people and includes 8 bunk beds, 2 Queen sized beds, and an 82" TV with a sound system. There is an HDMI port in the wall to project to the TV from a laptop. There is an outdoor deck and a large, newly built meeting/living room for meetings and gatherings, and a large fenced backyard.

A full modern kitchen includes an electric stove, coffee makers (including a Keurig), and a french door refrigerator with a water and ice dispenser. It is fully stocked with necessary cooking utensils and tableware.



The home includes 3.5 baths and recessed lighting throughout the house and has fast Fios high-speed internet with Google mesh wifi. The driveway can fit 2 cars and there is free street parking available.



Located close to the historic Frederick Douglass house and the Anacostia Community Museum, it's a perfect setup for small retreats in the city and for lodging for service/missions groups coming to Washington, DC.
